Welcome to the Experience Solensia Program! We're thrilled you and your cat will be joining us. No one knows your cat better than you—and your vet relies on you to let him or her know if anything changes. So your feedback is invaluable.

### Program Summary


Videos and surveys will be used to share your observations with your vet. That way, you can both help your cat take control of osteoarthritis (OA) pain. To make it easy, your videos will automatically be shared with your vet clinic!

### What Is Solensia?

- Solensia is a type of medicine called a biologic that targets a key root cause of your cat's OA pain<sup>1</sup>
- It works like your cat's naturally made antibodies to reduce pain signals<sup>1</sup>
- It controls OA pain in cats. After a single treatment, cats showed increased mobility<sup>2</sup>
- Most importantly, Solensia is a once-monthly injectable given in your vet's office

### Here's What You Can Expect

The program will consist of the following touchpoints:



- Your vet will send you a Welcome email. It has all the information you need to get started
- For the first visit, you'll upload several videos of your cat doing different actions. You and your vet will decide which action to track over the course of the program



Jumping up or down  
(eg, from a table or chair)



Climbing up or down a step



Walking



Running



Chasing

- For each of the following visits, you'll only upload 1 video, which you will review with your vet. This video should be taken 1 to 2 weeks before your vet visit. You'll get a prompt to upload it as a reminder. When setting up your account, you can select whether you'd like to get this reminder as an email or a text
- At each visit, your cat will be treated with Solensia. Then you and your vet will complete a survey together about your experience

### Set Yourself Up for Video Success

- Find a well-lit spot
- Feature only your 1 cat
- Capture the whole action from start to finish
- Use landscape mode if possible
- Record for up to 30 seconds—that will be long enough
- Make sure your uploaded video is less than 100 MB
